The Summer Splash is our hugely popular end of term event where the PTA **exclusively hire Sandford Parks Lido** for SJP families. Both pools are open and Lido lifeguards will be on duty.

This year the **Lido Cafe will be closed** (staffing issues) but the **PTA Tuck Shop will be open** selling water, soft drinks and crisps. Please bring your own picnic and you may bring your own drinks (soft & alcohol), but please use your own cups (no glass).

Everyone entering the Lido needs a ticket, regardless of age or whether they swim. This is NOT a PTA-supervised event, so you are responsible for your own children.
